In this fun and interactive concert, students will learn about the story of **Energy**, explore their own response to the climate crisis and understand the difference that they can make to the world.

Energy is an interactive orchestral performance aimed at KS2 pupils devised by Sinfonia Viva. This streamed performance features fourteen musicians from Sinfonia Viva performing with students from East Riding, presented by music leader James Redwood and science leader Melanie Boyeson, with live BSL interpretation

Concert programme:

- . Four original pieces composed specifically for **Energy**, by James Redwood and Hazel Gould
- . Music by Mozart, Cheryl Frances-Hoad and Beethoven
- . Premieres of four BRAND NEW pieces, written by students from East Riding

Learning Resources:

Energy is accompanied by a workbook of resources linking to the concert that allows teachers to:

- . Explore the science curriculum through tailored **Energy** activities.
- . Encourage children to think about their own musical response to **Energy** with creative composition activities.
- . Teach the story of **Energy** through engaging action games.
